SECTION A - CASE MANAGEMENT

Instructions:

For this section, you are asked to consider practical applications for the various acupuncture paradigms that will be reviewed each week. You are asked to prepare proposed treatments based on one of the 5 “styles” of acupuncture – see below. You will select a patient profile from one of the attached patient case profiles. You have 5 "styles" of acupuncture evaluation as choices.

1. Neuroanatomic and Myofascial Acupuncture
2. French Energetics, Circulation of Energy
3. Classical Chinese Medicine, Evaluation, and Therapy
4. Five Phases and the Regulation of Qi
5. Microsystems

Your home learning and our discussions at the weekly live sessions will be enhanced if you choose approaches that you don't use routinely. While the case histories are not your actual patients, the case analysis, acupuncture diagnosis, and proposed treatment should be based on the “style” utilized.

You are asked to submit 1 case prior to the week's discussion session. See the schedule/dates below for the sections that will be discussed. After reviewing the lecture and materials, please submit 1 case using 1 of that week's “styles” for the discussion session. You may choose to use the same patient case for multiple styles of treatment.
